Accommodations at the Hobby Center

We Arrive by Bus

Our bus stops in front of the theater.
We get off the bus
and walk into the
building together.



We Go Inside Together

There may be many buses and students from other schools. Our class stays together as we go inside.



We Wait and Find Our Seats

We will walk into the lobby and an usher will show us where to sit.



STEP 6

Use the Restroom

I can use the restroom at any time. It may be easier to go before the show starts.



Tools That Can Help



Headphones and fidgets are available upon request. Please see an usher to pick up these items.

I can ask my teacher for a break at any time.

We Sit Down and Wait

We walk to our seats. We sit down and wait for the show to start.



The Show Starts

The lights get darker. We hear a short welcome.
Then the show begins.



We Can Clap or Cheer

The performers may ask us to clap, cheer or participate.
I can join in, or I can stay quiet.



Helpers Are Here



Many volunteers and staff work at the Hobby Center.
I can ask an usher or my teacher a question.

The Performance Ends



At the end, the actors bow. We can clap. The lights get bright.

Questions and Answers



The performers will take questions from us! If my question doesn't get answered, I can submit my question on the student survey.

The Show Ends



Once the performers leave the stage we wait with our class. An usher tells us when it is time to go to the bus.
